Type 8



- The ornament in the lower left hand corner has no dots at all. The other three ornaments have, instead of dots, a pair of short lines protruding from each ring. Instead of a "Y" shaped figure between the rings, there are two short lines, often blotched together.
- The word "BOLLO" is much too small, and the serifs of the "B", if extended, would cut well into the rings of the corner ornament.
- The stops after "BAI" are round. The lower one is below the level of the letters and almost touches the serif of the "I".

Type 9



- The rings in the corner ornaments have extremely thin outlines and are of all sizes and shapes. The "Y" shaped figures are likewise assorted; some are short, others long; some are thick, others are thin; some attach to the center ring, while others sprout out of the side rings. The dots are entirely missing.
- The "B" of "BOLLO" is much larger than the corner ornament.
- The letters of "ROMAGNE" are of the ordinary type.
- There are two small, irregularly shaped stops after "BAI"
- None of the words have the hump on the side of the letter "O"
